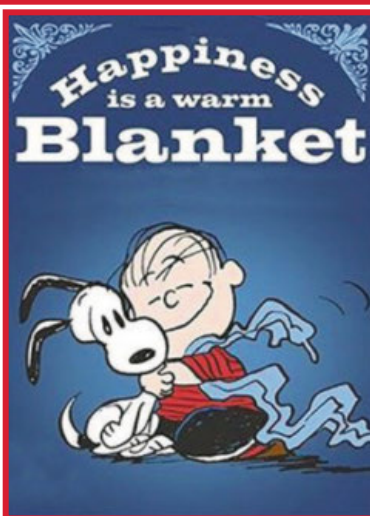
COME SEE "THE LETTER" - A DIALOGUE WITH POPE FRANCIS ON:

INTRODUCING THE TRAVELING VOCATIONS CROSS PROGRAM

Our parish is starting a new program. It is called the Traveling Vocations Cross.

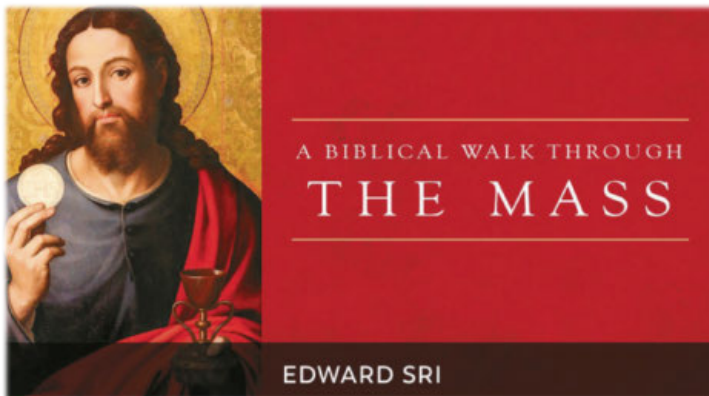
The program provides an opportunity to pray for vocations at home and to appreciate the value of Priesthood, Consecrated Life, and Marriage.

Starting October 22, the parishioner who has signed up will receive the travelling cross at the altar at the end of the 9 AM mass just after the Eucharist for the homebound is distributed.

The parishioner will pray during the week for vocations and return the traveling cross to the working sacristy before the following Sunday's 9 AM mass. The next parishioner who has signed up will receive it at the end of the 9 AM mass.

Parishioners sign up to volunteer their participation. A sign-up sheet will be available at the Vocations Ministry table at the Ministry Fair on October 14-15 and then in the narthex at the church. The parishioner who has the traveling cross agrees to return it and the prayer literature for transfer to the next parishioner.

It is the Vocations Ministry hope that this experience will encourage us to take seriously our vocation as a member of the Body of Christ and encourage all of us to pray for the gift of vocations, especially in religious life.

HELP WITH NAVIGATING THE MENTAL HEALTH SYSTEM

MENTAL HEALTH



"You are Not Alone by Dr. Ken Duckworth, is a refreshing resource filled with hope on the successes of our current mental health system. I wish I had this book to help my husband and me navigate our journey with our son who suffered from severe mental illness." - Rebecca

People experiencing mental illness and their families and friends are often unsure how to navigate this system, deal with financial and logistical issues and handle the emotional challenges of mental illness. This book serves as a guide to navigate the mental health system, with advice from experts and wisdom from real people and families.

Part One - Mental Health and Mental Health Conditions - Dr. Duckworth describes the barriers around mental health conditions such as cultural differences, distrust and lack of awareness. He illuminates the steps that have been taken in the right directions with the Mental Health Parity and Addiction Equity Act of 2008, which mandates insurers treat mental health and physical health equally. He discusses pathways to recovery with first person statements of the tools that have helped them.

Part Two - The Recovery focuses on evidence from lived experiences which help shed a light into awareness and acceptance of a diagnosis. He discusses how advocacy can change public policy. He cites ways to navigate the legal system, answers difficult, but often asked questions by parents, and informs on state of the art research and care.

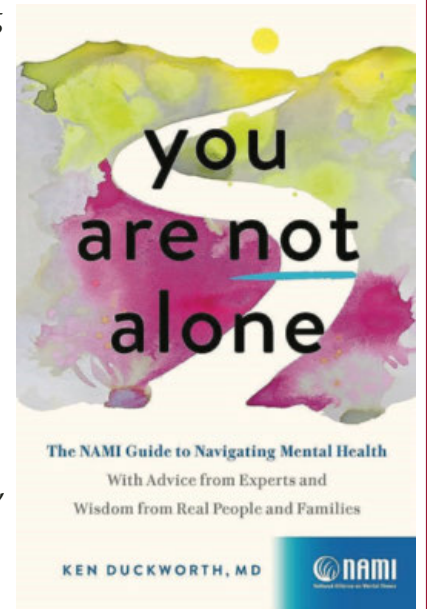
