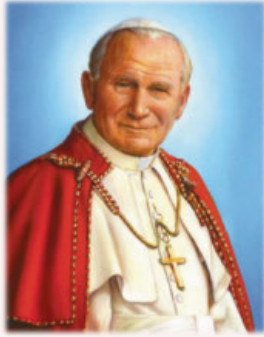

## SISTER KAREN BERRY'S FALL CLASSES – OVERVIEW OF THE BIBLE

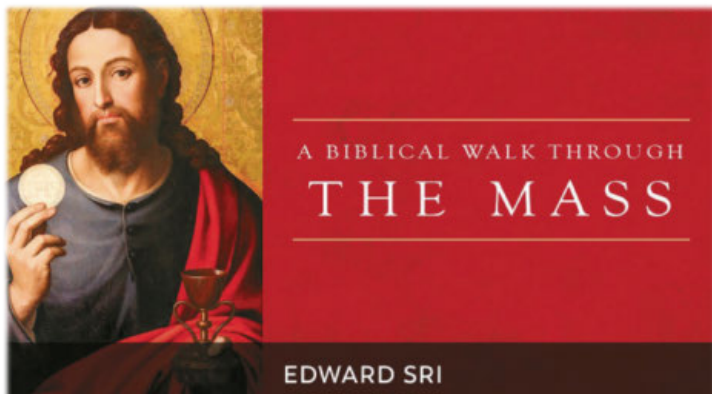

## NOVEMBER MENTAL HEALTH FOCUS – SUICIDE PREVENTION

### MENTAL HEALTH



Join the Mental Health Ministry as it presents its November Mental Health Focus on November 5 from 1-3 PM in the Parish Hall. Suicide affects every

walk of life. There is no typical suicide victim. The National Alliance on Mental
