



INTRODUCING THE TRAVELING VOCATIONS CROSS PROGRAM

Our parish is starting a new program. It is called the Traveling Vocations Cross. The program provides an opportunity to pray for vocations at home and to appreciate the value of Priesthood, Consecrated Life, and Marriage.


Starting October 22, the parishioner who has signed up will receive the travelling cross at the altar at the end of the 9 AM mass just after the Eucharist for the homebound is distributed.

The parishioner will pray during the week for vocations and return the traveling

cross to the working sacristy before the following Sunday's 9 AM mass. The next parishioner who has signed up will receive it at the end of the 9 AM mass.

Parishioners sign up to volunteer their participation. A sign-up sheet will be available at the Vocations Ministry table at the Ministry Fair on October 14-15 and then in the narthex at the church. The parishioner who has the traveling cross agrees to return it and the prayer literature for transfer to the next parishioner.

It is the Vocations Ministry hope that this experience will encourage us to take seriously our vocation as a member of the Body of Christ and encourage all of us to pray for the gift of vocations, especially in religious life.

Felicia's Farm was started to honor the memory of the founder's wife Felicia Cutler

whose vision was "to feed the people and teach them to feed themselves". Felicia's Farm donates an average of 700 pounds of produce and 130 dozen eggs every week, year-round, to boost the nutrition and food security of people who need help in our community.

The farm donates to several organizations including Casa Maria Food Kitchen and Pascua Yaqui pantry providing the protein (eggs) and fresh vegetables that are most of the time lacking in donations from other sources. They serve the elderly through LendAHand Senior Assistance and Estes Garden low income senior housing and people with mental illness through Our Place Clubhouse.

Felicia's Farm donates to organizations that take food out to people living on the streets. They also grow flowers to attract necessary pollinators, then donate them to local hospices including Peppi's House.

IMPACT OF SOUTHERN ARIZONA

Impact of Southern Arizona's mission is to empower Southern Arizonans with the resources required to pursue a stabilized and enhanced quality of life. Impact supports the local community with a food bank, the Loving Threads Clothing Bank, senior services, youth programs, community education, English as a Second Language courses and summer meal programs for school age children. Through providing these services, Impact works to help stressed households move to self-sufficiency through short term emergency aid, employment opportunities, job skills training, and workshops.

I Am You 360 is an award-winning, innovative organization. Desiree Cook's lived experience inspired her to revolutionize a movement called "I AM Somebody". The state of Arizona is home to 20,000 vulnerable youth. Through self-awareness, self-development, and the development of life skills, they can say "I AM Somebody".

"I Am You 360," believes in empowering the whole person by providing personalized and customized hygiene according to age, gender, and ethnicity, a 10-week self-development curriculum, life development, safe housing, and home ownership.

I Am You 360 has served over 3,000 youth and families with their programs and services within Pima County, Pascua Yaqui Tribe, Tohona O'odham Tribe, and Maricopa County.
