


Training sessions for volunteers interested in becoming EMHCs and

DO YOU OR SOMEONE YOU LOVE LIVE WITH

A MENTAL ILLNESS?



Join the Mental Health Ministry at its September Mental Health Focus to learn about different

mental illnesses and how it is possible to live a full life! The same program will be presented twice so feel free to attend the one that fits your schedule - September 17th from 1 - 3 pm OR September 25th from 6 - 8 pm in the Parish Hall.

National Alliance on Mental Illness (NAMI) will be conducting its "In Our Own Voice" program which is an interactive presentation that provides insight into what it is like to live with mental illness. Audiences are given a safe place to ask questions and gain understanding of an often misunderstood topic. Through dialogue, we begin to understand mental illness and the journey to recovery.

In addition to the video presentation, there will be guest speakers, resource information, and opportunities for Q & A.

SUICIDE PREVENTION WEEK

SEPTEMBER 10-16 IS NATIONAL SUICIDE PREVENTION WEEK

Suicide is not inevitable for anyone. By starting the conversation, providing support, and directing help to those who need it, we can prevent suicides and save lives. Evidence shows that providing support services, talking about suicide, reducing access to means of self-harm, and following up with loved ones are just some of the actions we can all take to help others.

The 988 Lifeline provides 24/7, free and confidential support for people in distress, and prevention and crisis resources for you or your loved ones. By offering immediate counseling to everyone that may need it, local crisis centers provide invaluable support at critical times and connect individuals to local services.

KNOW THE RISK FACTORS

Risk factors are characteristics that make it more likely that someone will consider, attempt, or die by suicide. They can't cause or predict a suicide attempt, but they're important to be aware of.

Mental disorders, particularly mood disorders, schizophrenia, anxiety disorders, and certain personality disorders Alcohol and other substance use disorders; Hopelessness; Impulsive and/or aggressive tendencies; History of trauma or abuse; Major physical illnesses; Previous suicide attempt(s); Family history of suicide; Job or financial loss; Loss of relationship(s); Lack of social support and sense of isolation

KNOW THE WARNING SIGNS

Some warning signs may help you determine if a loved one is at risk for suicide, especially if the behavior is new, has increased, or seems related to a painful event, loss, or change. If you or someone you know exhibits any of these, seek help by calling the Lifeline.

Talking about wanting to die or to kill themselves; Looking for a way to kill themselves, like searching online or buying a gun; Talking about feeling hopeless or having no reason to live; Talking about feeling trapped or in unbearable pain; Talking about being a burden to others; Increasing the use of alcohol or drugs; Acting anxious or agitated; behaving recklessly; Sleeping too little or too much; Withdrawing or isolating themselves; Showing rage or talking about seeking revenge; Extreme mood swings

If you or someone you know is experiencing a mental health crisis, call or text 988 immediately.





As we scan the media for the news of each day, sometimes we can only shake our heads and wonder where our humanity is headed. And then there are those shining stars – acts of kindness to one another, sometimes grand, sometimes simple. Caring words or acts of compassion, or just a sympathetic ear.
