1. Opening Prayer by Sr. Jean "What do we hope for in 2016"
2. Minutes were approved without change.
3. Cherie Gray, Executive Director of Tucson Refugee Ministry, (www.Tucsonrefugeeministry.com) presented information about the group and several ways in which we might become involved. There was much interest for our group to explore further on a Parish wide basis. The following is a synopsis of this portion of the meeting: (See Leslie's notes attached for additional information.)
 - a. An informational meeting will be held on Monday, February 8, from 6-9 PM at the Pima Street Baptist Church for people interested in learning more about the Tucson Refugee Ministry
 - b. If we have 20 people at a Volunteer information meeting, Cherie will hold a meeting at Santa Catalina; we will try for our own meeting of 20 or more people.
 - c. Mike will submit a bulletin announcement about the program and meeting when a date is selected.
 - d. Information about the program will be available at the January 17 Immigration meeting.
 - e. A Refugee Ministry Team consisting of Mike, Sr. Jean, Judy Lynch and Carolyn Sherwin was formed to pursue involvement by the Parish.
4. Casa Maria Facility Improvements: John Tancock
 - a. John outlined the results of his January 6, 2016 meeting with Brian Flagg and Caesar on additional improvements to the Casa Maria facility. Some improvements would be relatively minor while other will require contractor help. John submitted a complete listing of the projects being contemplated which has been provided to SAM members.
5. Manna Bags – Mary Hojnacki
 - a. Mary stated that sales have been excellent and in the future the sales after the 5 PM Mass will be discontinued due to low response.
6. Just Coffee – Al Crawford
 - a. 109 pounds were sold in December. A parishioner has donated \$210 worth of Just Coffee for Casa Maria which will be purchased and delivered in January and February.
7. Sister Jose Women's Center – Sr. Jean
 - a. The fundraising luncheon for the new facility is January 31, 2016 from 11:30-1:00 at the Westward Look Resort.

- b. To date 127 tickets have been sold at the Parish – an excellent result
 - c. Jean Fedigan and Sr. Jean expect 220-250 at the luncheon when the sales from St. Mark and other churches are in.
 - d. Next meeting of the Event committee is January 12.
 - e. Carolyn reported on the delivery of the toiletries gift bags to the Women’s Center was very well received by the ladies.

- a. Snack Pack Program -- Mike
Mike reported on the challenges of the fund collection this time. It was suggested that the collection be schedule earlier in the October or November time frame and that publicity on the program be improved to create greater awareness among the parishioners.
