Fr. Partin's Ponderings

As we draw closer to November 3 and all the debates are going on, it reminds me of the Redemptorist's virtue for September -- Mortification! LOL

This is one that we rarely hear about anymore, yet it is a good one to acquaint ourselves with.

Mortifications comes from the Latin, *mors* and *mortis* and translates as death. In the spiritual life mortification refers to voluntary actions by which we gradually "put to death" all of our vices, sinful habits, and self-centered tendencies. Today we commonly use terms such as *sacrifice*, *self-denial* or *doing without* too express the spiritual practices we voluntary perform.

From the time of the early church mortifications have been part of our spiritual discipline. In the Gospels we are told, "If anyone wants to be a follower of mine, let him renounce himself and take up his cross every day and follow me." (*Luke 9:23*) and "Anyone who wants to save his life will lose it; but anyone who loses his life for my sake, and for the sake of the gospel, will save it." (*Mark 8:35*). Even Paul wrote about this practice, "I pommel my body and subdue it." (*1 Corinthians 9:27*)

St. Alphonsus distinguishes external mortification as: fasting, controlling one's tongue and internal mortification "the discipline of the heart," overcoming aversions, resentments, and dangerous attachments. While both kinds of mortification are important, Alphonsus views the internal as both more demanding and more fruitful for spiritual growth.

During September you might reflect on the resentments or dangerous attachments in our life and pray for the grace to overcome them.

Pensamientos del Padre Partin's

A medida que nos acercamos al 3 de Noviembre y todos los debates continúan, me recuerda la virtud redentorista de septiembre -- ¡La mortificación! LOL

Este es uno del que rara vez escuchamos, sin embargo es bueno para familiarizarnos con nosotros.

La mortificación proviene del latín, mors y mortis y se traduce como muerte. En la vida espiritual, mortificación se refiere a acciones voluntarias mediante las cuales gradualmente "damos muerte" a todos nuestros vicios, hábitos pecaminosos y tendencias egocéntricas. Hoy en día usamos comúnmente términos a nuestros vicios como, sacrificio, abnegación o prescindir demasiado para expresar las prácticas espirituales que realizamos voluntariamente.

Desde el tiempo de la iglesia primitiva, las mortificaciones han sido parte de nuestra disciplina espiritual. En los Evangelios se nos dice, "Si alguno quiere ser seguidor mío, renuncie a sí mismo y cargue con su cruz todos los días y sígame." (Lucas 9:23) y "El que quiera salvar su vida, la perderá; pero el que pierda su vida por mí y por el evangelio, la salvará." (Marcos 8:35). Incluso Pablo escribía acerca de esta práctica, "Golpeo mi cuerpo y lo someto." (1 Corintios 9:27)

San Alfonso distingue la mortificación externa como: ayuno, control de la lengua y mortificación interna "La disciplina del corazón," superando las adersiones, resentimientos y apegos peligrosos. Si bien ambos tipos de mortificación son importantes, San Alfonso ve lo interno como más exigente y más fructífero para el crecimiento espiritual.

Durante Septiembre, puedes reflexionar sobre los resentimientos o apegos peligrosos en nuestra vida y orar por la gracia de superarlos.

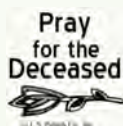

THE KNIGHTS SUPPORT SANTA CATALINA DURING PANDEMIC

It's been a very difficult year for most of us.

The Coronavirus has presented many challenges to our parish and all parishioners. We have been forced to dramatically reduce contact with others, protect ourselves with masks and sanitizers, and our church has been closed! The doors to our parish have been shut for the better part of the past six months. Those of us over 65 years of age were advised to remain home. Our lives have been turned inside out.

Fr. Lamar, our newly appointed pastor, boldly took steps to reduce the closures and implemented a series of programs designed to minimize the effects of these closings. Masses were streamed, outdoor confessions and the Eucharist were made available. Communication was, and is, more and more digital.

The month of May brought our pastor and knights together to plan a digital rosary for streaming. Agreement reached and arrangements made to have a group of Knights of Columbus members perform the rosary and have it streamed to the parish. Your Council was pleased to support the parish with this endeavor.

Your Knights were again called upon to aid in the planning and implementation of the outdoor Masses scheduled during the month of July and then into August. Fr. Lamar also asked the Knights to provide parking lot service prior to and after each Mass. We also assisted in the set-up and take down of the temporary altar, directing traffic to communion, and other miscellaneous tasks required to support the effort.

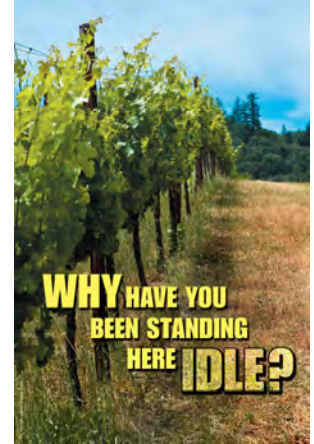

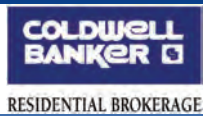
